1st YEAR

- **Pastoral Experience**
 - Attend Finance Meetings once a month
 - Attend FAMMILY Meetings once a month (Church Council)
 - Preach at least once a quarter on Sunday
 - Assist in Baptisms
 - Assist in leading the Lord's Supper
 - Work with either the Children's Ministry or Youth Ministry
(Depending on their strengths)
 - Visit people in his area & also the MCC church
 - Go to city council meetings to get approval for Backyard Bible Clubs
 - Deal with a mission team from the initial phone call until they leave
(Set everything up before they come)
 - Begins developing a "Mission Group Information Packet" for his area
 - Develop his church's website & publish it
- **Write out your personal doctrinal statement**
- **Develop a Strategy for the New Church**
 - Work through Basic Training topics (one a month for 9 months)
 - 1) **Spiritual Disciplines**
 - How do you develop Spiritually?
 - 2) **Core Values**
 - The foundation of the new church
 - 3) **Vision**
 - Direction of where you are going
 - 4) **Master Plan**
 - Where do people fit in & where are you leading them
 - 5) **Leadership Development**
